## how to get there

Wanaka Airport is situated 10km from Lake Wanaka township on State Highway 6 at Luggate. Wanaka is centrally situated and is easy to reach by road. Other options include coach, aircharter or private aircraft.

**BY ROAD** Distances from other townships are as follows:

Alexandra 86kms, Christchurch 431kms, Cromwell 55kms, Dunedin 280kms, Invercargill 307kms, Oamaru 236kms, Omarama 113kms, Queenstown 120kms, Timaru 280kms, Twizel 130kms

Allow extra travelling time for delays on airshow days.

**BY AIR** International Airports are situated at Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch and Dunedin and scheduled flights into Queenstown can be arranged through Air New Zealand or Qantas New Zealand from these airports. From Queenstown to Wanaka your travel can be by car coach or charter aircraft. Charter flights will operate from several locations around New Zealand.
