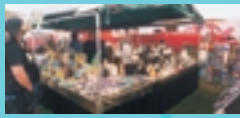


3 day aviation trade expo and craft market

terms and conditions

1. No replacements or refunds can be given on any pre-paid passes if they have been mislaid in anyway or if they are not used in full or in part.
2. If any of the three days of the airshow or any particular performance, display, exhibit is cancelled, abandoned or postponed in whole or in part due to adverse weather conditions or for any cause which is beyond the organisers control, there is no right to a refund or exchange and no obligation is assumed by the organisers for the arrangement of a substitute event, performance display or exhibition.
3. Program displays and exhibitions may be subject to alteration without notice. The right is reserved to vary, add, withdraw or substitute performances, exhibits and displays.
4. It is a condition of entry that all persons attending this airshow assume full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, death and property damage whether caused by the negligence of the management of Warbirds Over Wanaka, their employees, or agents or otherwise while the person is entering or leaving any part of the airfield and parking areas.
5. The rights of refusal of entry and removal from the airfield or parking areas are reserved to the organisers.
6. Gold Pass tickets are subject to availability.
7. Still and moving photography is permitted from the Warbirds Over Wanaka venue for private use and bonafide use by news media only. Commercial use of images may be permitted by negotiation with Warbirds Over Wanaka.
8. Public camping of any kind including motor homes is not permitted on the airfield or in any of the designated vehicle parking areas or in the private aircraft parking area. All vehicles must vacate the parking areas at the conclusion of each days performance.
9. Dogs are not permitted on the airfield.
10. Gate sales are on a cash only basis. EFTPOS is not available at the gates.
