The Airshow gates open at 7.30am each day. Site holders are expected to be onsite operating from 8am to 4.30pm over the three days of the Airshow. The official Airshow flying programme runs from 10am to 4pm on Saturday and Sunday.

2. SITE INFORMATION

We expect over 130 unique stands, and this is an opportunity for customers to purchase your products/services and find out more about your business.

All sites and all facilities will be mapped accurately. Your input of correct measurements is crucial. We will be strict on Aircraft taking up more space than booked.

You will be required to provide a detailed plan of your site layout, specifying aircraft and any marquee location within your designated site.

Please note marquees are not included with the outside sites, however marquees and extra equipment can be booked through the application form or alternatively you can supply your own. If you are providing your own marquee, please ensure it is suitable for unexpected severe weather conditions and preferably made of fire-retardant material.

Additional equipment may be ordered on the application form.

We will not be taking any commission on your sales.

3 POWER

Power is available at an additional cost, please book power on the online application form. Power will be available from 8am Thursday 2 April until 5pm Sunday 5 April. *Please note overnight power is an additional cost.*

- All vendors using power must comply with the AS/NZS3000:2007 Electrical Installations Standard and AS/NZS3002:2008 Electrical Installation - Show and Carnivals Standard (www.standards.co.nz).
- All vendors will be checked to confirm compliance upon arrival before they are able to connect to any power source on site. (Electrical Warrant of Fitness, all cables with current test tags).
- Failure to comply with these requirements will result in the vendor being removed from site, until compliance to the above Standards are met. The Warbirds Over Wanaka power supplier will charge for servicing equipment on \$135 per hour rate.
- Exhibitors may bring their own Generator on site; the generator noise must be less than 75dBa at 1m in order to minimise the disruption to other site holders and members of the public. Details of your generator will be required as part of your application.

4. OTHER INFORMATION

- There will be no ATMs or cash-out facilities available at the Airshow.
- There is an opportunity to advertise your business in the official Warbirds Over Wanaka printed programme. The programme rate card is available, please note on the application form if you are interested in advertising.

5. HEALTH AND SAFETY PROCESS

PLEASE NOTE: NO AIRCRAFT ARE TO HAVE ENGINES RUNNING OR START UP ON ANY GRASSED AREA.

- Participation as Aircraft for Sale site holder at Warbirds Over Wanaka is in accordance with compliance under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015.
- Both Warbirds Over Wanaka and the site holder are equally responsible for providing and maintaining a safe work environment for workers and visitors to the site and for ensuring that all parties have taken reasonably practicable steps to prevent harm within the site.
- Health and safety information and an online site induction will be sent out prior to the event. This will need to be completed prior to the site holder coming on site.
- Our Health & Safety consultant will be onsite from Thursday to chat with you about Health and Safety while at Warbirds Over Wanaka.
- Aircraft parked in public display areas must have markers attached to their aircraft tie-downs to alert members of the public to a potential trip hazard.
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6. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- a) On acceptance of your application, you will be issued a deposit invoice of \$500 plus GST, due for payment within two weeks of being issued. Your site will be confirmed on payment of the deposit invoice.
- b) All fees relating to each site must be paid prior to the event, any unpaid fees will result in your site being cancelled.
- c) Full Payment of the site must be paid by the 20 February 2026
- d) All sites must be set up no later than 6.00pm on Thursday 2 April 2026
- e) All sites must operate for the entire three days of the event.
- f) You must comply with parking location instructions. Any trade vehicles allowed on the main trade site area must remain there for the duration of the event.
- g) Trade Exhibitors who use signage to advertise their site must have clear and aesthetically appealing signage. Exhibitors must provide their own means of displaying signs securely, all signage must be within the boundary of the exhibitors' site.
- h) Security will be on the airfield each night and no camping will be allowed.

- i) All sites must be vacated on Sunday evening 5 April 2026, please note that no trailers or equipment are to be left on your site on Sunday night.
 - j) Warbirds Over Wanaka reserves the right of acceptance and placement of your site.
 - k) In the event that Warbirds Over Wanaka is cancelled, before the event starts, a \$50 administration fee will be deducted from any refund to stall holders.
 - l) There will be no refund if the air show runs on two or more days.
 - m) Any cancelation after the 20 January 2026, the site deposit is non-refundable.
 - n) Any cancelation after 20 February 2026, refund of site fees will be at the discretion of management.
 - o) Aircraft for sale site holders are responsible for the insurance cover of their site during the show, including Airshow pack in/pack out period. Warbirds Over Wanaka carries no insurance or liability cover for trade site holders personal or business items.
