International airports are at Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, Dunedin and Queenstown. Scheduled flights into Queenstown are through Air New Zealand, Qantas, Virgin Australia and Jetstar. From Queenstown to Wanaka your travel can be by car, shuttle, coach, helicopter or charter aircraft.

The Warhorse re-enactment group and Frankie Singers will entertain while you check out the aviation stands, market stalls, vintage engines and lots more. All food and beverage options open today. While aircraft will be practicing throughout the day there is no formal airshow scheduled.

Lake Event

Later on Friday afternoon join us on the Wanaka lakefront for our very popular aircraft displays over the Lake with its stunning mountain backdrop (this is a free community event).

Gates open at 7.30am - All static aircraft displays, aviation trade stands, market stalls, merchandise and food and beverage vendors are operational so come early to check out the action on the ground before the aerial displays begin at 10am.
